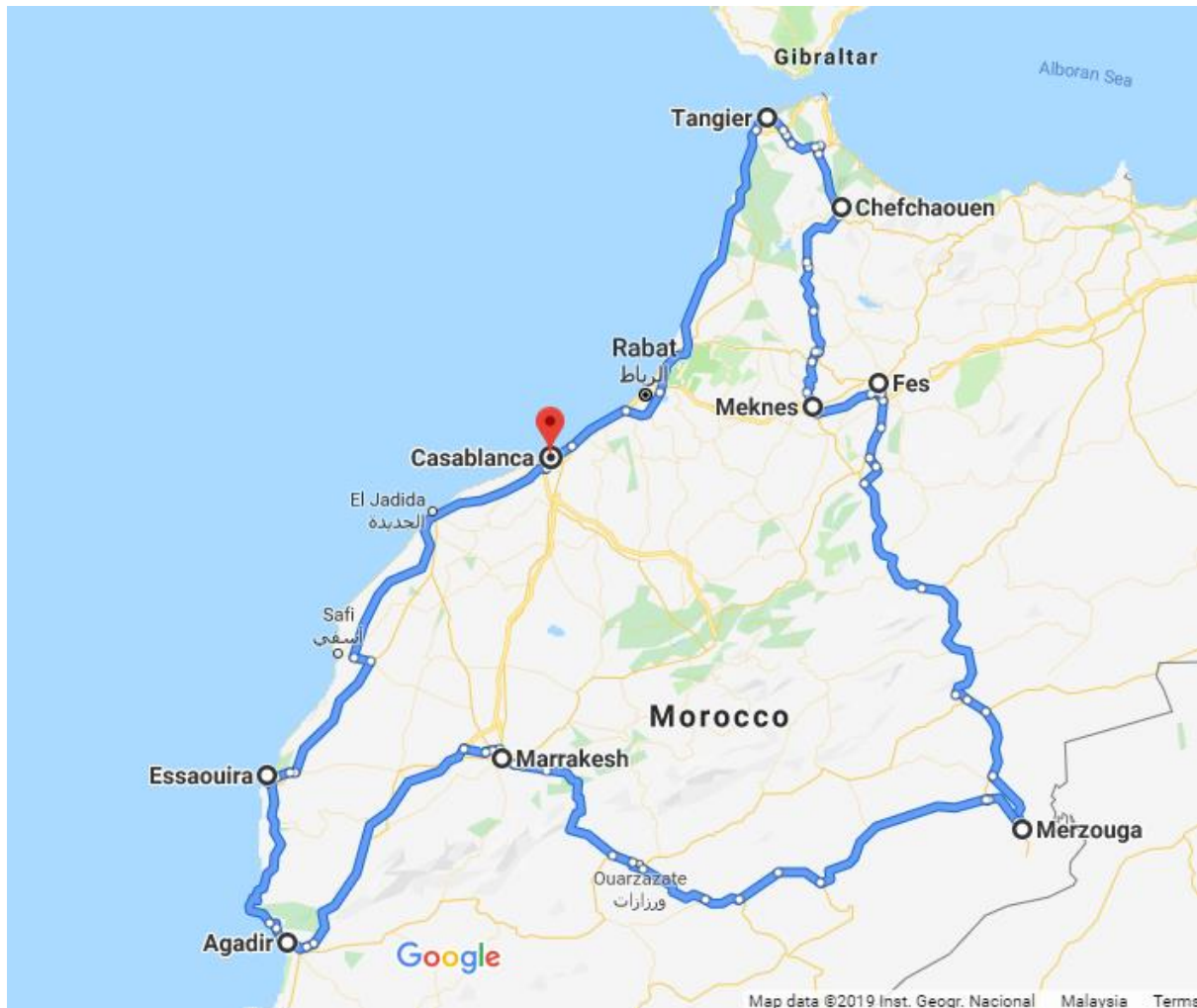




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BEST OF MOROCCO & SAHARA EXPERIENCE TOUR

15 DAYS 14 NIGHTS



Day 1. Casablanca

A warm welcome by our guide at Mohammed V International Airport, Casablanca. Visit to **Hassan 11 Mosque** – the largest mosque in Morocco and 13th in the world. Its minaret is the world's tallest at 210 metres about 60 storey high with the top a lesser beaming toward Mecca. The mosque part sit on land and part sit on the Atlantic Ocean. The mosque can hold 105,000 worshippers with 25,000 at the inside mosque hall and 80,000 at the outside mosque ground. Overnight at Casablanca.

Day 2. Casablanca – Rabat (87km, 1h) – Assilah (210km, 2h) – Tangier (46km, 45m)

Breakfast. We drive to Unesco World Heritage Imperial city of Rabat, which is the administrative centre for Morocco. We will visit **Oudaias Kasbah, Hasan Tower & Mausoleum of Mohammed V.**

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Continue our journey to Assilah, a beautiful, artsy, small, seaside town on the coast of Morocco. We will drive to Tangier, a Moroccan port on the Strait of Gibraltar, which has been a strategic gateway between Africa and Europe since Phoenician times. Overnight at Tangier.

Day 3. Tangier – Chefchaouen (250km, 4h)

Breakfast. Visit Tangier places of interest: **St Andrew, The Grand Mosque, The Grand Socco** and **Cape Malabata**. We drive to the beautiful Blue Mountain City of Chefchaouen situated in the Rif Mountain on the Northwest of Morocco. The city with uniquely building on the slope offer guests amazing experiencing the entire city on foot with it charming blue wash houses of various shades. Vibrant street with colorful products at every corner. This city is a living art with different tribes from the mountain region wearing their traditional attire. Overnight at Chefchaouen

Day 4. Chefchaouen – Volubilis (164km, 3h 15m) – Meknes (32km, 1h) – Fes (66km, 1h)

Breakfast. We continue our adventure to **Volubilis**, the Unesco Heritage Site of the ruin from the Roman Empire founded in the 3rd BC. Volubilis is the capital of Idrisid dynasty, the great grandson of Prophet Muhammad who is buried at nearby Moulay Idris. Our journey continue to the 2nd imperial city of Morocco, Meknes. Visit **Bab Mansour, Lahdim Square** and **Bassin de l'Aguedal**. We take a drive to Fes; the 3rd imperial city. Overnight at Fes.

Day 5. Fes Explore

Fes is the oldest imperial cities of Morocco as well as the spiritual capital of the country. Fes medina, Fes El Bali is also listed on the World Heritage Site as the one of the largest urban pedestrian zones in the world. The city is founded in 789 and the word Fes mean “axe”. Immediately after a traditional Moroccan breakfast, we will be greeted by our guide for a medina walking tour.

- **Qaraouiyyine mosque** open its door in 895 which houses more than 4000 rare books and ancient Arabic manuscripts written by well-known scholar
- **Nejjarine Museum of Wooden Crafts.**
- **Fes El Bali** – the oldest part of the medina.
- **Bab Boujloud** – the blue gate.
- **Medersa Bou Inania**
- **The Mellah**
- **Tanneries**

Overnight at Fes.

Day 6. Fes – Infrane (64km, 1h) – Midelt (135km, 2h 30m) – Mezouga (263km, 4h 15m).

Breakfast. We will depart for famous ski resort of Morocco-Infrane. Travelling through the highland and valley, guests are presented with nature beauty of great valley open up to oasis view along the way. Infrane is famous for its stone lion sculpture and of course the modern European highland housing. Our journey to Merzouga the entrance gateway to the Sahara Desert change the high rocky mountain to the plain vast golden sand of dunes. Overnight at a sand hay built hotel in the middle of the dunes.

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Day 7. Merzouga – Rissani – Erg Chebbi

Capture the romantic silhouette of rising sun against your body for an early morning view of the sun rising behind the dunes. Breakfast at the hotel and get ready to continue our journey into the Sahara. Our journey to Rissani – the former glory of the Alawite ruler and the city boast one of the earliest Moroccan elaborate architecture work. The **main gate** – lavish design with bright colour and **Rissani souk**. Merzouga – the entry point into the Sahara Desert. A 45 minutes **camel ride** into the amazing back drop of pure red sand dunes of sunset from the horizon. Arrival at the luxury camp with private bathroom. Relax and fresh-up for an unforgettable experience dining in the middle of Sahara Desert. A traditional Berber tangine dinner will be served. Attend a campfire performance by Berbers. Siting under the constellation of star with sky as clear as diamond, listen to the stories of the nomad. Overnight at Sahara Desert Luxury Camp.

Day 8. Merzouga – Todra Gorge (200km, 3h) – Quarzazate (180km, 2h 30m)

Breakfast. Transferred out by 4X4 and drive to **Todra Gorge**, the majestic rocky mountain that has been halved by the flowing Todra river. We will walk along the river and feel the amazing height of the gorge. As we travel to Ouarzazate, we will pass by the beautiful **Rose valley**. Of course, only during the summer you will be able to smell the aroma of the roses permeate the whole valley. According to report by “Research Gate” Morocco ranks 3rd in the world production of rose oil. We will visit their showroom as well as a toilet stop. Overnight at Ouarzazate.

Day 9. Ouarzazate – Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou (30 Km, 30 Min) – Marrakech (196km, 4h)

Breakfast. **Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou** – A UNESCO World Heritage site with its location on the southern side of the High Atlas, it has preserved its architectural authenticity with regard to configuration and materials of the 17th century style of building. It is one of the most beautiful Kasbahs in Morocco. We continue to visit the world largest film production studio, **Atlas Film Studio**. Many blockbuster such as “Lawrence of Arabia”, “Kundun”, “Gladiator” and etc are done here. Argan oil used by the local Amazigh people famous for its healing properties. 30 Kilograms of nuts is required to produce 1 kilogram of oil. We will visit the **Women’s Co-Operative** and have a first-hand view of how the Argan Oil is being produced mainly by hand. We continue our journey to Marrakech and overnight at Marrakech.

Day 10. Marrakech Explore

Breakfast. Visit **Majorelle Garden**, beautiful garden belongs to the famous designer YSL. **Koutoubia Mosque** – the largest mosque in Marrakech with one of the oldest Almohad minarets remaining in the world. It was built in the 11th century with a beautiful 70m high minaret and it is an active mosque. **Saadian Tomb** – 16th century tomb, a burial ground of 66 of the Saadian dynasty members. It has the most beautiful and jewel encased tomb in the whole of Morocco. **Bahia Palace** – a 19th century palace. This palace is built in the 19th century for the grandest palace of the time, beautiful garden, fountain, and atriums. All the rooms for the wife and concubine is decorated according to the rank and favourite of the King. Enjoy the famous chaotic **Jemaa El Fna** square and souk. Overnight at Marrakech.



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Day 11. Marrakech Free & Easy

Breakfast. You may choose optional day tour to Ourika valley + berbers village or day trip to Ouzoud waterfalls or simply just spend more time to enjoy the city itself!

Day 12. Marrakech – Agadir (175km, 3h)

Breakfast. We drive towards Agadir for some relaxing time on some of the most beautiful ocean with modern coastline of French influences, south of Morocco. **Musee Munipipal** - in commemoration of the reconstruction of Agadir, 40 years after earthquake that destroy the whole city, **Polizzi Medina, Old Kasbah**. Enjoying the beach promenade and excellent cuisine being offer.

Day 13. Agadir – Essaouira (175km, 3h)

After breakfast we will drive to Essaouira for some of the best live seafood from Morocco. Dine in front of the beach. Visit Skala Fortress, the port, the souk and enjoy the work of Thuya wood craving by artisans. Overnight at Essaouira.

Day 14. Essaouira – El Jadida – Casablanca (377km, 4h 30m)

Breakfast. Visit the Unesco world heritage site - Portuguese city of Mazagan. Depart to Casablanca.

Day 15. Casablanca Transfer to Mohammed V International airport

After breakfast, we transfer you to your outbound destination.
