RED LINE | 7 DAYS 6 NIGHTS | Depart every Saturday

Saturday. Casablanca – Marrakesh [258km] (D)

Pick up at 9am, depart to Marrakech. Marrakech Imperial City Exploration with our local expert: the famous YSL designer private garden – **Majorelle Garden**; **Koutoubia Mosque** - an important landmark of Marrakech; the historic mausoleum – **Saadian Tomb**; Visit the 19th century greatest palace – **Bahia Palace**. At the evening, enjoy the famous chaotic **Jemaa El Fna** square and souk.

Sunday. Marrakech – Ouarzazate [213km] (B,D)

“Hollywood” Day Tour: The ancient village **Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou**, where “Game of Thrones”, “The Mummy” etc were filmed. Explore the world largest film studio – **Atlas Film Studio**. Many sets from the filming of various movies remain in place including “Kundun”, “Gladiator”, etc. Along the journey, we will cross the most beautiful landscapes of the High Atlas through the passage of Tizi n'Tichka. The scenery changes at the turn of each turn! En route, visit the **women’s cooperative** to take a look of the making of Argan oil.

Monday. Ouarzazate – Sahara Desert [365km] (B,D)

Today, enjoy the scenic route on our way to the great Sahara Desert, amazed by the view of “The route of Thousand Kasbah”. En route, we will stop by the magnificent **Todra gorge**, a thousand years natural formation. Walk along the river and feel the amazing height of the gorge. Upon arrival, embark on a Sahara Desert Excursion: enjoy the slow and buoyancy **camel ride** and experience the **great Sahara sunset** looming over the extensive golden sand dunes. Capture beautiful moment of your ride with our camel man’s help. When we reach our gorgeous campsite, relax and freshen up before a **traditional dinner** is served. **Berber’s hypnotic drum performance** will entertain you too. Enjoy the magical feel of overnight in the great mysterious Sahara desert. Let time pass slowly tonight and pretend we were the nomads.

Tuesday. Merzouga – Infrane – Fes [469km] (B,D)

As we travel along and heading towards the oldest imperial city - Fes, you will be mesmerized by the contrast view of the sandy desert grounds in the foreground with lush olive and palm trees and the snow-capped Atlas mountains at the background. Rest stop in the small Swiss of Morocco, Infrane and a photo together with the **famous stone lion sculpture**, who has sat there since Second World War.

Wednesday. Fes Day Tour (B,D)

Medina of Fes, the largest urban pedestrian zones in the world. Today, we will visit the **Royal Palace** and **Zellige making facilities**. Medina Guided Tour: World oldest and continually operating university – **Qarouiyine Mosque**; The beautiful Marinid architecture – **Madrassa Bou Inania**. The largest and best-known tannery in the heart of the souk - **Chouara Tannery**; the blue gate – **Bab Bou Jeloud**. Take a close look of the making of local leather without involve any modern technology. Take a short hike to **Borj Nord** and **Menerid Tomb**. Enjoy the full view of Fes from the top.

Thursday. Fes – Rabat - Casablanca [295km] (B,D)

After breakfast depart to the administrative city. Rabat City Tour: The ancient **Hassan Tower**, an unfinished minaret of a mosque which become the famous red sandstone landmark. On the opposite, is the **Mausoleum of Mohammed V**. Explore the 12th-century **Kasbah of the Udayas**, the city’s oldest quarter. Its signature, whitewashed and blue-based houses. Depart to the modern city, Casablanca. Must visit: **Hassan II Mosque**, the highest religious building in the world. Also, the only mosque that open to non-Muslims to visit.

Friday. Casablanca (B)

Breakfast. End of our service.

Thu. Fes – Meknes – Volubilis – Chefchaoeun
[262km] (D)

Pick up at 9am, depart for Meknes Imperial City Tour: **Lahdim Square**- Centre place of the old city and the incredible gate of **Bab Mansour**. Short drive to visit the archaeological site of Volubilis, the **Roman Ruins**. Continue our journey to the photogenic blue city, Chefchaoeun.

Friday. Chefchaoeun – Tangier [112km] (B,D)

Free & Easy: Dazzle yourself in the blue pearl of Morocco. Enjoy new angles of blue up and down the stairs, along the main arteries and through the small winding passageways. After lunch, depart to Tangier. A city in north-western Morocco, guarding the Strait of Gibraltar. It has for centuries been Europe's gateway to Africa.

Saturday. Tangier – Assilah – Rabat [256km] (B,D)

Breakfast, visit the beautiful **Caves of Hercules**, an ancient cave surrounded by legend. Right on top of it, it's the **Cape Spartel**. 1,000 feet above sea level at the entrance to the Strait of Gibraltar, where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea. A short drive to Assilah, the beach city. Also, a great place to try the very best fish and seafood of the Moroccan coast. Continue our journey to Rabat.

Sunday. Rabat – Casablanca [87km] (B,D)

Rabat City Tour: **The Hassan Tower**, an unfinished minaret of a mosque. On the opposite, is the **Mausoleum of Mohammed V**. Explore the 12th-century **Kasbah of the Udayas**, the city's oldest quarter. Drive to Casablanca. Must see place: Hassan II Mosque, the highest religious building in the world. Also, the only mosque that open to non-Muslims to visit.

Friday/Monday. Casablanca/Marrakech – Agadir
[502km] (D)

It's definitely a resort destination, known for its golf courses, wide crescent beach and seaside promenade lined with cafes, restaurants and bars.

Saturday/Tuesday. Agadir (B,D)

Start the day by visiting **Musee Municipal** - in commemoration of the reconstruction of Agadir, 40 years after earthquake that destroy the whole city, **Polizzi Medina** and **Old Kasbah**. Enjoy the beach promenade and excellent cuisine being offer.

Sunday/Wednesday. Agadir – Essaouira [175km] (B,D)

After breakfast we will drive to Essaouira for some of the best live seafood from Morocco. It's also a beautiful beach town popular for surfing, windsurfing and kitesurfing. Stroll along the beach and dine in front of the beach! Visit **Skala Fortress, the port, the souk** and enjoy the work of Thuya wood craving by artisans.

Monday/Thursday. Essaouira – El Jadida – Casablanca [386km] (B,D)

Free and easy at the morning. After lunch, we depart to Casablanca. En route, visit the Unesco world heritage site - **Portuguese city of Mazagan** at El Jadida. Overnight at Casablanca.

Tuesday/ Friday. Casablanca. (B)

Breakfast. End of our services.

Before Booking You Should Know...

The following indications are of interest to you and complement our **TERMS AND CONDITION**:

ITINERARIES:

Detailed itinerary is available in your booking voucher. Under exceptional circumstances, Morocco2u reserves the right to modify the sites visited, the order of the visits or the stages of itineraries.

MEETING POINT OR DEPARTURE POINT:

The starting point for the beginning of a tour will be stated in your booking voucher. It is very important that travellers check the place of departure on their booking voucher. No shows at that place on that date and time confirmed can involve losing the purchased services without any right to a refund of the same, with a lack of punctuality incurring the same consequences, both at the beginning of a tour and during the course of the same.

TOUR GUIDES:

All our overland routes, unless otherwise noted, include the support of accompanying local tour guides (English speaking). There will be no assistance from any guides on additional nights or end of the tour. If the customer undertakes a sector of circuit, the assistance of the guides begin at the moment when the group that constitutes the tour arrive in the place where the passenger will join it.

HOTELS:

Hotel list are available in the brochure. While this information is indicative of the standard of planned hotels. We might be obliged to replace the foreseen hotel, in some cases especially during the high season, with other similar of the same category before arriving the destination. It is important to print the definitive list of hotels (booking voucher) before the start date. The passenger is responsible for all damages caused in the hotels/coaches, for injuries caused to other passengers and third parties, as well as for fines and expenses that Morocco2u is obliged to pay to the authorities on their behalf.

- **Location and comfort:** Our hotels are not luxury, but they have the necessary comfort, are always in the destination cities.
- **Check –in, check-out:** The hotel check-in usually about 14:00 hrs, and the check out about 10:00 hrs. If you want your room to be available more time, consider booking an extra night.
- **Double, twin & triple room:** Morocco2u cannot guarantee requested room type. However for shared rooms, twin room will be arranged. In many hotels there are no triple rooms. We do not recommend booking triple rooms for three adults, we would only suggest this for families travelling with a child.
- **Kettles, hair dryer, tea/café facilities:** It is not usual for there to be kettles, hair dryer or facilities to prepare tea or coffee inside the rooms of Morocco hotels.
- **Safety box:** We recommend keeping personal belongings such as basic and important documents like passport, money, jewellery, electronic items or valuable in the safety box of the hotels. Pay attention to your bags in the common areas of the hotel such as reception, or restaurant as Morocco2u will not accept any liability of the loss or theft of the above mentioned personal belongings.

ADDITIONAL NIGHTS:

Pre and post accommodation is only valid for travellers who purchase tours with Morocco2u, provided that these nights immediately precede or are a direct extension of our tour.

TRANSFER POLICY:

Morocco2u tour does not include transfer from the airport/train station/port/hotel in the city where the passenger will join the tour to the meeting point (vice versa). In the event that transfer are purchased, these could be private or shared with other passenger. The driver will wait a maximum of 1 hour time. In case the passenger is retained or delayed due to any cause inside the airport, he should call the emergency number provided by Morocco2u.

TRANSPORT:

The services provided by Morocco2u are overland and are made by coach, with the size of the vehicle being adapted according to the number of passengers. Morocco2u does not have coaches with access ramps for wheelchairs or car booster for baby. If the number of registered participants on a circuit is very low, in order to fulfil our commitment of “Guaranteed Departures”, Morocco2u may provide a private vehicle or minivan driven by our guide.

LUGGAGE:

The luggage allowed for each passenger on our tours is limited to one piece of a maximum of 30kg per person (note airlines have their own limits). Morocco2u may refuse to accept excessively bulky luggage. Morocco2u is not responsible for the luggage, one piece per person when it is travelling inside the coach. (Not allowed to leave it inside overnight, except for the night stay at Sahara Desert Luxury Camp). The passenger is fully responsible for its luggage during the entire journey. It is allowed to take a bag or day-pack (without wheels) in the coach cabin, although the passenger is responsible for their custody. Never leave your belongings on the bus; take them with you, even at the stops, because Morocco2u shall not be responsible for loss or theft, nor for your personal belongings left or forgotten on the coach.

MEALS:

Morocco2u tours provide daily hotel breakfast and hotel dinner (if stated). Hotel breakfast and dinner are usually buffet. Riad will be traditional Moroccan food. No refund if meals is not taken.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Morocco2u does not arrange travel insurance for all its passenger and thus it is compulsory that the passenger purchase his own travel insurance before joining the tour.

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE:

In the event that an emergency arises during the tour, the passenger should inform as soon as possible the accompanying tour guide. Furthermore, Morocco2u provides a 24 hour emergency telephone, which passengers can use, and details can be found on their booking voucher. Non-urgent matters will not be dealt with on these calls, and nor will they respond to questions that do not relate to emergencies en route (reservation, rates, questions about availability).

START AND END OF OUR SERVICES:

The services provided by Morocco2u are overland. They start at the time when the customer receives the first service provided by our company (after the border and custom formalities), and end when the customer receives the last scheduled service (transfer, breakfast or the corresponding service, according to the purchased package). Morocco2u is not responsible for the consequences or circumstances arising from services that are not provided by our company (flight disruption, loss or damage on flights, problems at borders/custom, those related to personal documentation, etc.)

OUR PRICES INCLUDE:

In each route, Morocco2u specifies the services included on the trip. As a general rule, what is not specifically listed as included in the tour price, is excluded.

OUR PRICES EXCLUDE:

All our tours does not include any insurance provide to customer. In general, any service that is not detailed as being included in the program contract or information will be provided to the traveller. E.g: airport taxes, visas, tips (Which are obligatory, min of 4 Euro per pax per day must be paid directly to the driver and/or guide), extras in hotels and optional activities.

REGISTRATION:

Booking may be made through our official website, email, Facebook (Morocco2u), Whatsapp or our customer service hotline. Customer can check the information (names, dates, tours, etc) that Morocco2u provides on the booking voucher which confirms their services.

CANCELLATIONS:

You may cancel your booking by notifying Morocco2u. Cancellation fees, if any, will be determined with reference to the date on which notice of cancellation is received by Morocco2u and are expressed as a percentage of the total price paid for the cancelled tour, product or service.

Cancellation of a Tour:

- (a) 30-16 days before the start of the tour 60% loss of the total price.
- (b) 15-8 days before the start of the tour 70% of the total price.
- (c) 7-3 days before the start of the tour 80% of the total prices.
- (d) Less than 3 days before the start of the tour is 100% of the total price.

NO SHOWS:

No shows at the start of the trip, without prior cancellation or in the event that, during the tour, a customer has to cancel their tour, they will not be entitled to any refund.

MODIFICATION OF BOOKINGS:

Changes made to a confirmed booking prior to the start of a trip and more than 30 days before departure (changes to the start date of trip, change of tour, etc.) are subject to processing/ relevant fees. Morocco2u shall not be held responsible for the expenses arising from the changes of booking.

DISCOUNT POLICY:

In order to obtain the discount listed at the time of booking, it is necessary to attach a copy of the document that justifies the said discount at the time of the trip. (Document that specifies the date of birth and etc.) No discount can be granted if there is no information at the time of booking. These discount will not be made on any type of supplements (single room and etc.)

- Children under 3 years: FOC and will not entitled to a bus seat or a bed.
- Children 3 – 6 years: Bus seat but no bed, 20% discount.
- Children 7 years and above: Considered as an adult and will be charge as the same price as an adult.
- Senior citizens: No discount is entitled.

SHARED BOOKINGS:

Morocco2u will accept "shared" bookings for individual travellers (same sex but different age) on all our tours at no additional cost. No reservations will be accepted for sharing on additional nights.

GURANTEED DEPARTURES:

All our tours have guaranteed departures, although in extremely limited cases, it could transpire Morocco2u is unable to operate a given departure. In these cases, Morocco2u will provide the same trip on an earlier or later date than the one chosen or customer may request for a full refund. Cancellations of guaranteed departures may arise (without compensation or liability on behalf of Morocco2u) in cases of exceptional unforeseen circumstances, among others, wartime conflicts, terrorist attacks, natural disasters, epidemics and economic circumstances that generate a very significant drop in the expected sales.

NON-ADMITTANCE OF PASSENGER:

A moderate degree of physical health and physical ability is required to participate in our tours. In the event of any passenger over 70 years of age or with special physical or mental needs, Morocco2u must be informed in writing at the time of booking, which will be analysed on a case by case basis, and it is possible that Morocco2u may request a medical report. In cases in which the customer accepts the tour, Morocco2u cannot assume any responsibility in relation to the difficulty or impossibility that the said passenger may encounter during the tour, nor can Morocco2u assume any responsibility for providing assistance for their adaptation to, or continuation of the trip. No reservations will be accepted and Morocco2u reserves the right to suspend any tour for passenger who's physical and/or mental conditions make their participation in it very difficult or dangerous to themselves or others. Morocco2u likewise reserves the right to exclude passengers who significantly disrupt the smooth-running of the trip.

DOCUMENTATION:

All passengers must bring their valid documentation (passport, visas, health certificate, etc). If the passenger is not carrying the required documentation, or due to a rejected visa application or instances where the traveller is denied passage through any border for any reason, Morocco2u cannot undertake any arrangements or make any reimbursement for services that cannot be used in such cases.

COMPLAINTS:

Passenger shall bring any complaints directly and immediately to Morocco2u any issue arises in order to provide Morocco2u with the opportunity to properly address such complaint. Any complaint made after the completion of a Tour will not be entertained.
